### The One Table



During the Season of Easter, the Easter (Paschal) Candle is to be placed close to the ambo. In our parish the Easter Candle is placed between the ambo and the altar. The placement of the Easter Candle meant no one could walk between the ambo and the

altar. When Ordinary Time begins we are to move the Easter Candle close to the baptismal font. The Church reminds us that "The liturgy of the Word and liturgy of the Eucharist together form 'one single act of worship', the Eucharistic table set for us is the table both of the Word of God and of the Body of the Lord." Catechism of the Catholic Church par. 1346.

During every celebration of Mass, we hear God's Word proclaimed and like the disciples on the road to Emmaus with our hearts burning we offer our praise and thanks to God and are fed the Body and Blood of Christ.

To highlight and strengthen our understanding of the unity of the one table we are learning not to walk between the two tables.


